Club Compass is a weekly program, provided at no cost, for low-income, underserved elementary students in grades K-5 of Springfield Public Schools - District 186. Program components include snack time, social-emotional learning (SEL), academic time, life skills / enrichment lessons with community partners, a family-style dinner, and weekend food through the Backpack Feeding Program.

Youth Leadership Development Program (YLDP)

YLDP is the newest program of Compass for Kids, specifically designed for middle and high school alumni of Club Compass. The purpose of this program is to prepare the youth to graduate from high school and be ready to achieve their dreams. YLDP does this through implementing an evidence-based social-emotional curriculum, life and job skills classes, field trips, and service learning projects.





Camp Compass is a nationally-award winning summer learning program for underserved elementary-age children focused on preventing summer learning loss and closing the achievement and opportunity gaps between low-income children and their higher-income peers. The program includes academic instruction and enrichment activities. This program is offered in partnership with Springfield Public Schools - District 186.

When Nelly, an 8th grader, joined the Youth Leadership Development Program (YLDP), she shared that one of her biggest goals was to speak up more. As a quieter student, she wanted to work on sharing her thoughts with others.

Recently, we introduced a new leadership opportunity where older YLDP students lead icebreakers for the group. After going through facilitation training, Nelly's group was up—but her peers were hesitant. Without missing a beat, Nelly stepped up, introduced their activity, and led with confidence! We can't wait to see her continue to grow as a leader at YLDP and beyond!



Olivia

Olivia, a 3rd grader, made incredible strides at Camp Compass. Her post-Camp assessment showed that she improved both her reading speed and accuracy. When she came to Camp she could read 54 words per minute with 96% accuracy, and by the end of Camp she could read 80 words per minute with 100% accuracy! She also increased both her multiplication and division math facts by 20%!
